Places to Visit near IIT Bhilai


Chhattisgarh is a hidden gem for travelers, offering a mix of natural beauty, cultural heritage, and adventure activities. Here are some top tourist places to visit:

Chitrakot Waterfalls



Chitrakot Waterfalls, also known as the "Niagara Falls of India," is a breathtaking natural wonder located in the Bastar district of Chhattisgarh. It is 30 meters high with approximately 300 meters width which makes it the wildest waterfall in India. This waterfall is on the Indrawati River which flows through Vidnhy mountain ranges.

Tirathgarh Falls



Tirathgarh Falls, located in the Kanger Valley National Park in Chhattisgarh, is a breathtaking waterfall that offers a serene and picturesque experience. It has a height of 91 meters and surrounded by lush green forest

and rugged terrain, creating a stunning natural backdrop.

Bhoramdeo Temple



Bhoramdeo Temple, located in the Kabirdham district of Chhattisgarh, is a stunning ancient Hindu temple dedicated to Lord Shiva. It's often referred to as the "Khajuraho of Chhattisgarh". It is built between the 7th and 11th centuries. The main temple features a 60x40 feet pavilion with four central pillars and 12 peripheral pillars, supporting the roof.

Kanger Valley National Park



Kanger Valley National Park is a stunning natural wonder known for its biodiversity, unique landscapes, and geological formations. The park is home to over 15 limestone caves, including the famous Kotamsar, Kailash, and Dandak caves, featuring stunning stalactite and stalagmite formations.

Other attractions: a non-ending list of such places also include Madku Dweep, Mainpat, Sirpur Heritage Site, Indravati National Park, Barnawapara, Danteshwari Temple, Ratanpur, Tatapani Balrampur etc.
